Curriculum Information for Parents

English

Children will have a daily English lesson which will incorporate the following:
Speaking and Listening, Phonics, Extended Writing, Extended Reading, Handwriting,

Science

The children will look at how things float and sink. They will be investigating different materials and their every day suitability.

Maths

During this term, children will be looking at place value, addition and subtraction. Children will be using a range of equipment during this term to support their learning.

History

The children will be looking at the lives of significant individuals in the past who have contributed to national and international achievements.
The children will also look at key explorers from the past.

Topic: Land Ahoy

Geography

The children will be taught to name, locate and identify characteristics of the four countries and capital cities of the UK and its surrounding seas.

Art

The children will begin to develop a wide range of art and design techniques and use a range of materials creatively to design and make products.

Computing

Children will have computing lessons where they will enhance their computing skills across the curriculum. They will be learning about instructions and algorithms to use in a software called 'Scratch'.

Design & Technology

The children will be exploring and using different mechanisms then making products.
The children will be making their own boats and will explore how they can be made stronger, stiffer and more stable.

P.E.

Children will be developing their gymnastic abilities throughout this term, looking at developing the key fundamentals such as balance, speed and co-ordination.

R.E.

Children will be learning about Islam, Muslims and the Mosque. They will begin to learn about this religion by understanding their beliefs, their way of life and things that are special to them as part of their religion.
